### **Hello LCI Shipmates and friends,**

It's reunion time again and we want to invite everyone! We hope you can make room in your schedules to come spend some time with your old shipmates. This is a special year – the 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary of D-Day. In gathering together this year, we will be celebrating Americana with a trip to the past as well as commemorating the scale and sacrifice made during the largest amphibious landing the world has ever seen.

This year's reunion will be held at the Red Lion Hotel at the Quay in Vancouver, Washington and you can participate in any or all of the events.

### **Thursday, September 25, 2014**

### **Friday, September 26, 2014**

We then continue our coach tour toward Cedar Creek Grist Mill. En route we'll be treated to an exciting narrative by our historian and cold case sleuth, Dave McKay. He'll tell us about the Grist Mill Murder, which garnered national attention because of a twist in the tale.

We'll be given a "working tour" of how the mill still works today with no electricity! We'll "mill" around there for an hour or so before heading back to arrive at the hotel around 5 p.m. The Grist Mill volunteers have also been kind enough to do a special opening just for us.

The Chelatchie Prairie Railroad train excursion travels through a 330' tunnel, over a wooden bridge, glimpses the Lewis River, and visits a waterfall. After years of neglect, a group of community volunteers came together in 1998 with the goal of returning it to a functioning historical railroad. The all volunteer, non-profit group also restored the track and resumed excursion service in 2001. Their passion and dedication sound similar to that of the AFMM volunteers! The locomotive is a 1941 Macintosh & Seymour 539. Please check their website for more historical information.

The Mill was built in 1867 and restored by volunteers to its original condition. Volunteers used period tools in restoring the Cedar Shake Shed, utilizing mortise and tenon to form joints. 11 tons of water per minute are needed to run the Grist Mill! Huge pulleys and belts turn and churn to produce flour and corn meal. We'll be given a sample of flour to take home. The scenery alone is inspiring: a covered bridge, roaring creek and flume. Here is another example of dedicated volunteers preserving history. Their website offers more information on history and restoration.
